American Red Cross Scholarships

American Society for Quality Scholarship

To apply, you must have a 3.0+ GPA and you must be planning to pursue a degree in math, science, or engineering. Pick up an application form from Mrs. Grabowski.

Michigan Sugar Company Memorial Scholarship

To apply, you must have participated in the Michigan Sugar Youth Sugar Beet program and have completed a sugar beet project. The scholarships are worth \$1,000.00 and \$2,500.00

April 21, 2008

Co/op Optical Memorial Scholarship

To apply, you must have a 2.0+ GPA and you must not be related to an employee of Co/op Optical or to a teacher. All applicants must write an essay on "How My Pursuit of Excellence Will Impact My Community and the World."

America Business Women's Association Scholarship

This scholarship is open to any female senior planning on attending a trade school or community college in the fall. The scholarship is worth \$1,000.00

Bluewater Area MSU Alumni Club Scholarship

To apply, you must have been accepted by MSU for the fall 2008 semester and must be a resident of St. Clair County.

Emmett Lions Club Scholarship

This scholarship is for students planning on enrolling in a trade or business school after high school. If that is you, please be sure to pick up an application form in the counseling office.

Belle River Community Credit Union Scholarship

AAA Michigan – School Safety Patrol Scholarship

Hey, were you a safety patrol member? If so, this scholarship is for you. Applicants must show proof of safety patrol participation, have a good academic record, and must have participated in community service.

May 1, 2008

Lake Superior State University Philip A. Hart Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is a full tuition scholarship renewable for up to 4 years and is also available to 5th year teaching majors. Graduates of Michigan high schools or community colleges planning to attend L.S.S.U. are encouraged to apply. Candidates must have a cumulative 3.0 grade point average as of their current year of study. The successful candidates must demonstrate interest in public service, as reflected through leadership roles and volunteer activities in their school and community.

June 2, 2008

Jeptha Wade Schureman Scholarship

This scholarship is for students who have lost their fathers due to death or loss of parental rights. To apply, you must demonstrate financial need, have a GPA of 3.0 or better, demonstrate leadership and character, and must be planning on a career in law, dentistry, nursing, or medicine.
